Regime change was required urgently


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

















INDICTMENT

The Constitutional Charges

The 17th Amendment effectively made our Senators viceroys of Washington, DC. Why? Prior to the 17th Amendment, state legislatures elected the Senators. This ensured that the Senator represented the interests of the state.
